


#### Quick Facts

Landscaping and stone facing for the two tunnels under Muirfield Dr. that were repaired and lengthened will occur once good weather is guaranteed.

Notice the short streetlights burned out on Muirfield Dr. or elsewhere? Make a note of the exact location, and notify AEP at <https://www.aepohio.com/outages/>. They will not be aware unless YOU report it. Tall streetlights, such as those in the Brand Rd. roundabout, are owned by the City of Dublin. Report outages via the City website at <http://dublinohiousa.gov/request/street-light-out/>.

As you read about school funding in the Governor's budget know this: Per-pupil funding statewide averages \$3,200. Some districts may be getting \$6,000 or more per student. Dublin's state funding is only \$855! When you read about percent increases districts may get in the new budget, do the math. Dublin's share will still be minimal.

The Water Tower under construction behind the Bogy will hold a half million gallons of water, one-fourth the capacity of the tower in Avery Park, but the same as the tower near Glacier Ridge Elementary. Height above sea level had to be identical to the other towers with which it is connected. Painting will be complete before the Presidents Cup. Fire hydrants and homes in the northeast quadrant of Muirfield will see a needed increase in pressure.



### VOLUNTEER SPOTLIGHT

### MUIRFIELD RESIDENTS UNITE FOR KIDSMILES CLINIC

When Muirfield resident and local orthodontist **Jim Homon** decided that something needed to be done to provide affordable dental care to low-income, working families in central Ohio, he knew it would be a challenge. "Building a non-profit organization from the ground up is daunting," says Homon. "We started slowly with a board of dedicated dentists and have grown steadily over the past four years. I am so pleased that the KidSMILES Pediatric Dental Clinic is now a reality."

The clinic, which provides comprehensive dental services to children at a cost of \$10 per visit, opened on December 18, 2012. To maximize care and keep costs low, KidSMILES' relies on volunteers to complete most of the required tasks, including dental services. "The KidSMILES model would not work without volunteers," says Homon. "Not only do we need dental professionals to complete the treatments, we need folks to help with mailings, educational outreach, database management and other routine tasks. Luckily, more than 375 volunteers have signed up to help."

Many of those supporters are Muirfield residents. **Julie Homon**, who is as passionate as her husband about affordable dental care, became the Executive Director in 2010. **Amy Daniels** serves as the organization's Deputy Director, assisting with grant proposals

and non-profit operations. **Laura Zuber** spearheads the educational outreach program that teaches elementary and preschool children in high-risk areas about the need for good oral health. **Carolyn Kubacki** manages the organization's comprehensive donor and volunteer database. **Anne Partridge** is an enthusiastic advocate, raising both awareness and funds. **Carol Homon** serves as the chair of the silent auction committee and has been an ardent supporter since KidSMILES' inception.




