

CIVIC ACTION COMMITTEE

Update on Road and Path Construction in and near Muirfield

The almost "non" winter allowed construction crews to catch up for time lost last June/July, which was an extremely rainy period. CAC Chair Bob Fathman spoke to Dublin's Engineering Manager for Traffic, Jeannie Willis and has the latest info:

270/33 on schedule once again. ODOT says all lanes and ramps will be open and running by November. Blacktop plants shut down for the winter, but in Spring 2017 final layers of asphalt will be laid and final striping/landscaping complete. The interchange will be totally functional by the end of November and dressed up pretty by Tournament time 2017.

Roundabout near Bridge Park. Also on schedule to complete by this winter. This includes the moved roadway, Rt. 257. Another exciting development! Remember to keep making efforts to patronize the businesses on both sides of the river.

Pedestrian/bike bridge between Bridge Park and the Library area. This iconic bridge is in final design right now, and its two-year construction will occur in 2017-18. The park on the east end will be partly finished before that, but will complete after bridge construction ends.

John Shields Parkway, Phase 2. This new road will connect Rt. 257 to Village Parkway

Celebrating great junior golf

THE COUNTRY CLUB AT MUIRFIELD VILLAGE JUNIOR GOLF PROGRAM

Over the past 18 years, TCC's junior golf program has produced:

- •2 players on the PGA Tour: Kyle Reifers and Chris Wilson

The success of The Country Club at Muirfeld Village junior golf program can be attributed to many factors. The program was established as a training system for boys and girls who will be our future golfers and club members. Educating juniors about course etiquette and the rules of the game plays a key role. Proper instruction gives them the ability to take their games to another level. But equally important, course access gives them a chance to play. Being on the course not only allows them to develop their skills, but also helps maintain their interest in the game of golf.

At many private golf facilities across the United States, juniors receive limited playing privileges or course access. Too many restrictions limiting course access may result in a real disservice to the juniors, to the game of golf, and to the facility. On the other hand, too few restrictions may result in unhappy adult members who pay a lot of money to belong to and play golf at a private facility.

That's why it is extremely important to maximize junior course access without disrupting the enjoyment of the golf course by adult club members. Without proper levels of course access you may end up with the most educated and best ball-striking range players in the country, but it could be detrimental to the growth and development of a junior golfer. TCC has successfully achieved this balance.

A "hands-on" approach to learning is stressed. The instruction portion of the clinics covers all aspects of the game – putting, chipping, pitching, bunker play, short irons, long irons, and woods. Skill contests are included to demonstrate what has been learned and to give a sense of competition. In the etiquette segment the kids are taken on the course and taught how to properly enter, exit and rake a bunker. They are shown the importance of replacing a divot and the proper procedure, how to fix ball marks on the

green, where to stand when someone in the group is putting. And, of course, proper clubhouse manners are also discussed. In the rules segment the juniors are clearly shown how to proceed in certain situations, such as relief from a water hazard or out-of-bounds procedures.

But most importantly, the kids are taught to Have Fun and Enjoy the Game of Golf!

[near the AMC cinemas] and from there on to Sawmill Rd, open by this winter. A new traffic bridge from the Rt. 257 terminus of Shields to Rt. 745 [N. High St.] will likely be added to the 5-year Capital Improvements Plan this summer, to be constructed in about 5 years.

Glick Rd. Path. The section from Davington [near Deer Run School] to Muirfield Drive will hopefully be under construction this summer, once land acquisition completes. It will finish by fall. The phase from Carnoustie to Muirkirk [across from the Glick Rd. Pool and playground] will occur as soon as a court allows eminent domain of one property. Then the path will be continuous between Avery and Dublin Rd.

Roundabout at Avery and Brand Rds. Detailed engineering design is underway this year. That will lead to land acquisition. Construction should begin in 2017 immediately following the Tournament, with completion in early fall.

Double Roundabout at Avery-Muirfield and Perimeter and Perimeter Loop/Hospital. Project has been pushed back to 2020, giving us a break after all the Rt. 33 construction.

Intersection improvement at Muirfield and Memorial. Due to accidents here, this intersection in on the City's radar. Traffic counts will be made during this year's Tournament, to supplement counts of non-Tournament traffic. The City and consultants will then look into options, and community input will be solicited. Stay tuned.

All of these estimates are, of course, weather-dependent.




