

GROUNDS AND FACILITIES COMMITTEE MEETING

MAY 26, 2009

The meeting was called to order by Vice Chair Longstreth.

ATTENDEES: Longstreth, Williams, Ellinger, Pace, Oleksa, Russell, Smith, Burns and GM Zeier.

The minutes of the April meeting were approved but misspelling of Tom Oleksa's name was noted.

COMMITTEE REPORTS:

Landscaping noted that the front Muirfield entrance was sparse and required attention but the back was fine. Some plants were not blooming as planned.

Tom Oleksa has drawn up a plan and functions of the Communications committee and will present it to the other members shortly.

OLD BUSINESS:

GM Zeier reported that the mulching was almost complete and would be ready for the Memorial Tournament. The pools and spray parks were open with a short term glitch in temperature at the Glick pool. It appears that the Monday night basketball may not happen this year as the managers of this activity wanted to open it to other than Muirfield residents with a \$45.00 fee. However, the courts are being used. The theft of a crank at the tennis courts happened again. There are some minor problems with irrigation of the grassy areas near the pool.

NEW BUSINESS:

It was noted that the flowers at the Moors entrance were really looking good. GM Zeier indicated that the new food concessionaires were starting well and that there was a demand by residents for snow cones and pop corn. New umbrellas are coming to enhance the pools. One good note from our current economy was that an adequate supply of pool life guards was available. City seeding of the media has been postponed but will be completed. New markings on the walking trails with mile markers and direction will be implemented soon. Placement of the Memorial logo on the entrance has been postponed due to placement and color issues.

RESIDENTS:

There have been a number of complaints of barking dogs which should be referred to Dublin under a city ordinance. Another concern is the problem of deer which destroy vegetation and are a general nuisance. The committee had no immediate solution to this problem. It was noted that this was a citywide problem. Doug Smith suggested that the committee make this an Agenda item for our next meeting.

The next meeting is Monday, June 29th at 6 PM at the Muirfield Office.

Motion to adjourn was made by Oleksa and seconded by Russell.
