

GROUNDS AND FACILITIES COMMITTEE MEETING

Minutes of the April 2010 meeting were approved.

Landscaping: Beds have been planted and mulching completed. Members noted that the landscaping was even better than usual.

Facilities: The pools are ready to reopen. Recertification of Life Guards is almost complete. Contract with Muirfins has been executed and they will be back. The same Concession people will return and comments on their service were positive. New volleyball net was secured to replace the stolen one. Gym Rats basketball is returning and continues as a popular recreation for young players. GM Zeier reported that the ¼ mile markers had been completed.

Communications: GM Zeier urged all Committee members to have ideas for continuing improvements ready at the next meeting and that residents be contacted for their input as well. It is our mission to develop potential improvements to facilities and programs which would enhance living in Muirfield.

GM Zeier reported that the Trustees had decided to temporarily delay further action on the Muirfield stone signs. Principal reason was due to the redesign of the Glick-Dublin Road intersection.

Smith suggested that the pillars on the Muirfield-Brand sign be enhanced with a figure of a male golfer on one side and female on the other in black color. Discussion was tabled until next month on the issue.
