## NEW POOL HOURS FOR 2012

### HOLIDAY HOURS:

Memorial Weekend, May 26, 27 and 28, both pools open 10 am to 8 pm.

July 4<sup>th</sup> (Wednesday), both pools open 10 am to 8 pm.

Labor Day Weekend, September 1, 2 and 3, both pools open 10 am to 8 pm.

### REGULAR SUMMER HOURS:

Both pools open 12 noon to 8 pm May 29th thru August 27th (first day of school).

### BACK-TO-SCHOOL HOURS:

**Glick Road Pool** closes for the season at 8 pm, August 26th.

# 2012 SWIM LESSON INFORMATION

## SWIM LESSONS WILL BE HELD AT THE HOLBROOK RECREATION COMPLEX ONLY!

Registration for the Learn-To-Swim classes is accepted online thru the Association's website:

*Login to the Member's area with your username and password and select swim lesson sign-ups. If you do not have access to the internet, a member of the Association office staff will help you complete the online registration. Bring a credit card or check to the Association office during regular business hours of the registration week and a staff member will help get your child registered for lessons.*

### **BEFORE GOING ONLINE TO ENTER INFORMATION, BE AWARE OF THE FOLLOWING REQUIREMENTS:**

- If you have questions about your child's abilities and/or class selection, please contact Pool Manger, Chris Carter, before registering for a class.
- Pool phone numbers are listed on the front page of this sheet.
- **Fee for each two-week session is \$50 per child.**
- Credit card payment is required at the time of online registration.
- **No refunds will be returned after the first class.**
- A chart showing class availability will be visible online and updated as payment is verified.
- Descriptions of class objectives for each level are described below.
- Class size is limited. Admittance to class is on a first-sign-up basis. Not all levels will be offered at all sessions; check table below for class offerings.
- Registration for each session will be accepted only on the specific dates and times listed below.
- Confirmation of admittance into the class is determined at the time of registration.
- Each learn-to-swim class lasts 45 minutes, 5 days a week, Monday through Friday, for 2 weeks.
- All classes are instructed by certified Water Safety Instructors and/or Aides.
- Classes follow American Red Cross standards.

## **CLASS LEVELS OFFERED**

### **LEVEL 1 - Introduction to Water Skills**

Helps students feel comfortable in the water and to enjoy the water safely. Children must be independent in the water. Strongly recommend age 3 or older.

### **LEVEL 2 - FUNDAMENTAL AQUATIC SKILLS**

Gives students success with fundamental skills. Must be comfortable with getting face/head wet.

### **LEVEL 3 - STROKE DEVELOPMENT**

Builds on the skills in Level 2 by providing additional guided practice. Must be able to swim 5 yards independently.

### **LEVEL 4 - STROKE IMPROVEMENT**

Develops confidence in the strokes learned and to improve other aquatic skills. Must be able to swim half the length of the pool on both front and back.

### **LEVEL 5 - STROKE REFINEMENT**

Provides further coordination and refinement of strokes. Must be able to swim 1 full length of the pool with both front and back crawl strokes with proper breathing and half a length of elementary back stroke ("chicken, eagle, snake").

### **LEVEL 6 - SWIMMING/SKILL PROFICIENCY**

Refines the strokes so students swim with ease, efficiency, power and smoothness over greater distances. Must be able to swim 2 lengths of the pool with both front and back crawl strokes with proper breathing as well as 1 length of elementary back stroke and 1 length of breast stroke.

# RECREATION FACILITY RULES

- Every resident over 2 years of age shall have a Muirfield Association I.D. card to enter the pool or tennis facilities, whether swimming or not.
- Any property owner with an outstanding deed violation or delinquent assessment will not be permitted to use the recreation facilities or other common property. Please stop by the Association office during regular business hours to clear up the problem.
- 2012 update stickers will be issued at the pool front desk to all members in good standing.
- An adult family member may pick up five extra Guest Passes at the Association office.
- If your I.D. card is lost or missing, you may not use the facilities until you purchase a replacement I.D. card (\$10) at the Association office. If you find the original I.D. card, bring the replacement I.D. card to the Association office for a refund.
- Guests shall be accompanied by a resident and present a Guest Pass when entering the pool facilities, whether swimming or not.
- Each guest (over 2 years of age) shall pay a **\$2** per guest, per visit, fee if they do not have an acceptable Muirfield Guest Pass, whether swimming or not.
- All visitors shall sign the Guest Sign-In Sheet, identifying the resident who invited them and is responsible for them.
- Residents shall accompany their guests during the length of their visit at the facilities.
- Verification of children's residency may be checked by telephone if not accompanied by a parent or guardian.
- Children under 10 years of age will not be permitted to use the facilities unless accompanied by an adult or guardian at least 14 years of age.
- Read and follow the posted pool, diving well, waterslide and sprayground rules.
- Persons may be tested before using the diving well and waterslide.
- Notify staff of any medical problems.
- Only those over 18 years of age are permitted in the Hot Tub.
- All children who are not completely potty-trained must wear disposable swim diapers at all times while visiting the pool facility. Changing swim diapers frequently greatly lessens the chance of 'accidents' which cause pool closings.
- If a child has an 'accident' in the pool which results in the pool closing for treating and sanitizing, there will be a required reimbursement of \$100 from the responsible party to cover the Association's cost to properly treat and sanitize the pool and surrounding areas.
- Residents may bring coolers or bags into the pool facility, however staff will search coolers and bags for glass and/or alcohol.
- Park bicycles in bike racks only. The Association is not responsible for loss or damage.
- Do not roller blade or skateboard on the stairs, curbs, near the entry of the pools, or on tennis courts.
- The desk phone is for incoming calls only, and for staff use in an emergency.
- Alcohol and drugs are prohibited inside the facilities or on common property.
