**GUIDELINES FOR BASKETBALL EQUIPMENT INSTALLATION**

1. Installation of basketball equipment shall be approved by the Muirfield Design Control Committee before any work begins.
2. Basketball units shall be ground-mounted. Basketball goals shall not be mounted on the house.
3. The entire unit - pole, mounting bracket and backboard (front & back) - shall be painted the trim color of the house.
4. Clear acrylic or glass backboards do not need to be painted.
5. Portable basketball units shall be painted the trim color of the house and shall be stored indoors when not in use.
6. Provide a site plan of property showing the footprint of house on property, no-build lines, property lines, easements, etc. Basketball equipment may not be located in no-build zones.
7. On site plan, mark an X at the proposed location of the basketball unit.
8. Verify that it is a ground-mounted unit.
9. Provide written agreement that the unit will be painted the trim color of the house.
10. Provide several photos of the area where the unit will be located.
11. In some cases, landscape materials may be required to provide a barrier between neighboring properties.

By deed, the Design Control Committee has thirty days to respond to your request. However, we try to respond within 10 – 14 days.

Provide two copies of your request – one copy will be kept on file in our office, the other copy will be returned to you.

There is a \$5 fee for review of basketball equipment requests.
