Dear Muirfield Village Resident:

*Once again we are proud to offer information about the upcoming Memorial Tournament presented by Nationwide to be held **May 29 – June 4, 2017**. We hope you share in our excitement of the coming Memorial and will be able to enjoy all that the week has to offer. Each year the Memorial Tournament staff works to ensure we have an effective plan in place to work with Muirfield Village residents with respect to operations and traffic flow. Our goal is simply to reduce the inconvenience and enhance the experience for residents and all the patrons who attend the tournament.*

Please take a few minutes to read the below information. We hope the detail provides assistance with planning your Tournament week.

THE MEMORIAL TOURNAMENT PARKING POLICIES

The Memorial Tournament Parking Committee has formulated the following policies in conjunction with Muirfield Village Association, Inc. and the City of Dublin.

Resident Parking: Four (4) Resident Parking passes are enclosed providing access to Muirfield Village in its entirety.

- Residents whose homes are located off of Kinross Court, Leven Links Court or Moray Court receive purple **Resident** parking passes.
- Residents whose homes are located off of Crossgate Drive and Crossgate Court receive red **Resident** parking passes.
- All others will receive gray **Resident** parking passes.

Guest of Resident Parking:

- Muirfield Village is divided into four (4) zones for **Guest of Resident** parking. Passes are issued according to the specified zone in which a resident lives. **Guest of Resident** parking access is limited to that specific zone only. For those residents whose homes are located off of Memorial Drive, east of Muirfield Drive, **Guest of Resident** parking passes will be gray. Residents, whose homes are located off Kinross Court, Leven Links Court, or Moray Court, will be given purple **Guest of Resident** parking passes. Those residents with homes located off of Crossgate Drive and Crossgate Court will receive red **Guest of Resident** parking passes. All other areas of Muirfield Village will receive lime green **Guest of Resident** parking passes.
- **Guest of Resident parking passes will be distributed at the same location as last year. ***NOTE NEW HOURS*****
The location is HNS Sports Group at 6189 Memorial Drive (located in Muirfield Square at the corner of Muirfield and Memorial Drive). Hours of operation are as follows:
 - Monday, May 22 through Friday, May 26 from 12:00 p.m. – 4:00 p.m.
 - Saturday, May 27 and Sunday, May 28 from 10:00 a.m. – 3:00 p.m.
- Your name and address **MUST be placed on each Guest of Resident parking pass** before leaving the distribution center - bringing a stamp or preprinted labels is recommended.
- During **Tournament Week**, additional Guest of Resident parking passes may be picked up at the HNS Sports Group Office (same location as the week prior to Tournament). Hours of operation are as follows:
 - Monday, May 29 9:00 a.m. – 5:00 p.m.
 - Tuesday, May 30 – Saturday, June 3 7:00 a.m. – 7:00 p.m.
 - Sunday, June 4 7:00 a.m. – 3:00 p.m.

Important Parking Regulations:

- If a Resident is renting his or her home, the homeowner must pick up all parking credentials. We regret that there are no exceptions.

- May 29 - June 4, 2017: Parking passes are required to be displayed on all Resident and Guest of Resident vehicles. Vehicles without parking credentials are subject to citation and/or towing.
- **ALL parking passes MUST have the name and address of the issued resident printed in the space provided for the passes to be valid.** This will allow law enforcement to check with the appropriate resident before towing a vehicle if it is parked illegally.
- Residents and Guests of Residents will be permitted parking only in the driveway of the resident issuing the pass. Please plan pass distribution accordingly.
- Carnoustie Drive will be designated "One Way" eastbound Tuesday – Sunday the week of the Tournament from 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. Please plan accordingly.
- Parking passes for construction crews and service trucks will be available by written request to the Tournament office prior to Tournament week. Please include the address or lot number where access will be needed. Parking passes will be valid Monday, May 29 through Sunday, June 4 only. Upon approval, the homeowner must pick up these passes at HNS Sports Group the week of May 22.
- If someone has illegally parked in a resident's driveway or in front of his/her home, call the **Tournament Parking Hotline** at (614) 889-6796. A tow truck will remove the vehicle.
- Mature landscape areas adjacent to cul-de-sac streets will be posted as a "TOW AWAY ZONE" during Tournament week.

TRAFFIC ADVISORY

Please note that on May 29, between 5-9 p.m., the Memorial Tournament will work with the City of Dublin to periodically interrupt traffic flow on southbound Muirfield Drive in front of the Country Club at Muirfield Village. This interruption is needed to allow load in operations to take place at the Country Club.

BEVERAGE CONTAINER POLICY

NO beverage containers (including water bottles) originating from residences or brought to the entrance gates will be permitted on the golf course. This policy is strictly enforced. Signs will be posted at all entrances and gate cuts.

SECURITY GUIDELINES

Please visit www.thememorialtournament.com for a list of *Policies & Prohibited Items* under "PATRON INFO". For security purposes, all residents and guests hereby consent to the reasonable inspection of your person and property before entering the Tournament, which inspection may include, without limitation, metal detection.

PROPERTY ADDITIONS – TENTS, RESTROOMS, ETC.

Please be advised and inform any companies renting a residence that the City of Dublin, Review Services and the Design Control Committee **MUST** approve any additions to your property, including tents and restrooms. If your home is located on the golf course all tents **MUST** be green in color. The Design Control Committee may be contacted through the Muirfield Association office at 8372 Muirfield Dr., Dublin, OH 43017. The City of Dublin, Review Services is located at 5800 Shier Rings Rd., Dublin, OH 43016, Attn: Alison LeRoy. The contact phone number is (614) 410-4503. This information was in your resident newsletter and all requests should have been turned in by May 8, 2017.

Dublin Fire Code requires a permit from the Washington Township Fire Department for all tents 200 sq. ft. in area or larger. Permits may be obtained through The Washington Township Fire Department, 6200 Eiterman Rd., Dublin, OH 43016 or by calling (614) 652-3920.

SIGNAGE

Respectfully, the Tournament requests that residents and corporate home renters acknowledge the instituted sign regulations. We ask that NO banners or other material be hung from houses or posted in yards adjacent to the Tournament course.

CART PATH ACTIVITY

We appreciate your cooperation in refraining from use of the cart paths for any activity (i.e. walking, jogging, children playing, pets, etc.). For safety purposes, the Memorial Tournament and Muirfield Village Golf Club are not responsible for injuries caused by errant golf shots or vehicular traffic on the cart paths.

We sincerely appreciate your cooperation with the procedures detailed above. We assure you that the Memorial Tournament presented by Nationwide and its liaison committees have given substantial thought to these policies for the protection and convenience of Muirfield Village residents and the Memorial Tournament patrons. Thank you for your adherence to these regulations and for your continued support.
